What is the difference between KAMP and Retreat?

KAMP (Korean Adoption Means Pride) focuses on adoption and the Korean-American experience. From Wednesday afternoon to early Friday evening parents and children explore Korean culture and adoption issues. We also have a lot of fun with our own families and old and new friends. The international retreat shifts its focus to other cultures. Most of the activities on Saturday allow the children to relax and enjoy time with the friends they have made during KAMP and make new friends with those attending Retreat. Saturday evening is filled with several activities including an international parade where the children dress in their native costumes, Korean dance and drum demonstrations from the KAMPers, a carnival for the youngsters, middle school game night, and a high school lock-in.

What is the process for assigning cabins?

At the beginning of June, the Riverview Conference Center provides a list of available cabins. In mid-July, preliminary cabin assignments are made based on order of registration receipt, family size, length of stay, pets, and special needs. On Monday (August 2), we will arrive at Riverview Conference Center and walk through all the cabins available to IIA for KAMP/Retreat. Assignments are then finalized. This list is provided to those assembling the KAMP/Retreat Welcome Packets and The Riverview Conference Center staff.
